Welcome and Announcements

WE READY OURSELVES TO WORSHIP

Reflect quietly and prayerfully on these words as we prepare to enter into worship.

Do you believe that God can do things that seem unbelievable?

I was recently confronted with this question in my own life when my sister called me, overflowing with excitement, to tell me that she had been healed!

For background: When my sister was very young, she suffered catastrophic damage to one of her inner ears that left her completely deaf on that side. For the last 48 years she has learned to live with that reality and made simple adjustments to her lifestyle that enabled her to function well. In the last few years she had a couple visits with her doctor who took X-rays of the damage and who suggested that she might be able to recover a small measure of her hearing with one of the new cochlear implants, but that it would probably only be slightly better than before.

Then, a few weeks ago, she had a dream in which she told me, that the Lord said he was going to heal her hearing. Like any of us, she was very skeptical, though trying to be hopeful that if the Lord could make the world out of nothing, he could surely do something like that.

Just a few days after this a man who she didn't know walked up to her in a park and said, "You are deaf in one ear, right?" To which she replied, somewhat sheepishly, "yes." He then said, "The Lord told me to blow into your ear." She was a bit freaked out, but because of the dream she had and because she didn't know this person at all, she let him blow a little puff of air into her ear.

Over the next several days, amazingly, she began to hear out of the bad ear, for the first time in almost 50 years. But, just to be sure, she went to her ear doctor who took new X-rays of her ear (which she shared with our family) and who then walked into the room and said, "You have recovered over 50% of your hearing since our last visit. I have no explanation for this. I have never seen this in over 30 years of my medical practice."



New Testament Reading—Acts 1:1-11

The Ascension of Christ

In the first book, O Theophilus, I have dealt with all that Jesus began to do and teach, until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commands through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. He presented himself alive to them after his suffering by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. And while staying with them he ordered them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, he said, "you heard from me; for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now." So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, will you at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." And when he had said these things, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, and said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven."






